What is the Asthma Diagnosis Decision Aid?

Asthma can be difficult to diagnose. To help improve the diagnosis of asthma, we have developed the asthma diagnosis decision aid. The asthma diagnosis decision aid is based on a calculator which provides the likelihood of asthma. It also provides information and advice based on the latest asthma guidelines.

What would I need to do?

We would like to hear your thoughts on the Asthma Diagnosis Decision Aid. Your consultation will run as normal. If appropriate, your GP or nurse may choose to use the Asthma diagnosis decision aid to help give them a better idea of whether or not you have asthma. If it is used, we would appreciate your thoughts - you will be asked to fill out a short questionnaire about your experiences and leave it at reception.
